



## Local Oral History Collections

### Introduction

The Archives and Special Collections Research Center in the Ball State University Libraries houses oral history collections comprised of interviews on a variety of topics that document the history of Muncie and Delaware County. This brief guide provides a description of some of the collections available. An interviewee list is provided at the end of the guide. Manuscript collections, photographs, and other research documenting the same topics may also be available. A guide to oral history interview collections related to Ball State will be added at a later date. In addition, new materials are added frequently. Consult Archives and Special Collections Research Center staff for more information.

### Audio Recordings

**William J. Nye Oral Histories (R 1)** Collection consists of 20 interviews (49 cassette tapes; 45 CDs) with World War I Veterans from Muncie, Indiana. Other local history topics and 3 cassette tapes on the Blizzard of 1978 are also included. Typed interview notes are available. For typed interview notes, see MSS 142.

**James Andrews Oral Histories (R 2)** Collection consists of 3 interviews (5 cassette tapes; 3 CDs) with World War I Veterans from Muncie, Indiana. Typed interview notes are available. For typed interview notes, see MSS 142.

**P. Douglas Magers Oral Histories (R 3)** Collection consists of 17 interviews (14 cassette tapes; 12 CDs) with World War I Veterans from Muncie, Indiana. Typed interview notes are available. For typed interview notes, see MSS 142.

**Jerry Handfield Oral Histories (R 4)** Collection consists of 8 interviews (10 cassette tapes; 11 CDs) with World War I veterans from Muncie, Indiana. Typed interview notes are available. For typed interview notes, see MSS 142.

**Black Muncie History Project, 1971-78 (R 5)** Collection consists of 38 interviews (37 cassette tapes, 20 hours; 11 reel-to-reel tapes). This oral history project was conducted in the 1970s by Hurley Goodall and Ball State University professor J. Paul Mitchell. There are typed transcripts available. For typed transcripts and other materials, see MSS 33. Related information can be found in Dr. J. Paul Mitchell Papers (University Archives, RG 4/1/28). Tapes and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository (<http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**Daniel B. Crowder Oral Histories (R 6)** Collection consists of 18 interviews (18 reel-to-reel tapes) done with members of the Local 287, UAW-CIO in 1969. Typed interview notes are available.

**Don Garrison Oral Histories (R 7)** Collection consists of 1 interview (1 cassette tape) with three-time Indianapolis 500 winner Louis Meyer about auto racing in the early 1920s.

**Muncie History Oral Histories (R 9)** Collection consists of 3 interviews (7 cassette tapes) on local history topics.

**Thomas P. and Eva Mann Oral Histories (R 10)** Collection consists of an interview (1 reel-to-reel tape) entitled "Going West with Grandfather Mann." Typed transcript is available. For transcript and other documents from the Mann family, see MSS 46; for photographs, see PSC 11.

**Cecil Beeson Oral Histories (R 11)** Collection consists of 8 interviews (9 cassette tapes) on local history topics from 1975-1976.

**Peace Movement Oral Histories (R 12)** Collection consists of 9 interviews (11 original cassette tapes, 10 user copies) conducted in 1981 with students and faculty involved in the peace movement on campus during the 1960s. Unedited transcripts are available.

**Aging in Muncie Oral Histories (R 13)** Collection consists of 18 interviews (18 cassette tapes) conducted in 1981 for the History 220, Aging in Muncie Oral History Project. Biographical information and interview notes are available.

**Muncie Jewish Oral History Project (R 14)** Collection consists of 21 interviews (24 cassette tapes, 15 hours). This project was conducted in 1979 under the sponsorship of Mr. Martin Schwartz, who commissioned Ball State University professors C. Warren Vander Hill and Dwight Hoover to interview Jewish residents who had lived in Muncie in the 1920s and 1930s. Typed transcripts are available. Tapes and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository <http://libx.bsu.edu>.

**William Sutton Oral Histories (R 15)** Collection consists of 1 interview (1 cassette tape). The interview was conducted in 1980 as part of the Carl Sandburg Oral History Project.

**B-Western Movies Oral Histories (R 17)** Collection consists of 10 interviews (10 cassette tapes) conducted in 1981 as part of a History 499 class project on the history of the "B" Western movie. Students interviewed local residents about their memories of going to the Saturday morning matinee Western movies in Muncie, Indiana. Unedited transcripts are available.

**Temple Beth El Centennial Celebration (R 19)** Collection consists of 3 tapes recorded as part of a celebration to commemorate the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the building of Temple Beth El in Muncie, Indiana.

**Black Middletown Oral Histories, 1981 (R 21)** Collection consists of 54 interviews (65 cassette tapes, 65 hours) conducted by researchers from the University of Virginia and Virginia Commonwealth University as part of the Middletown II Project. Typed transcripts are available. Tapes and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository <http://libx.bsu.edu>.

**Muncie Civic Theatre Oral Histories (R 22)** Collection consists of 24 interviews (24 cassettes and 1 reel-to-reel tape) of interviews with members of the Muncie Civic Theatre in 1985. The interviews were conducted as part of the Community Theatre in Middletown Project. One interview has been transcribed.

**Unitarian Universalist Church Oral Histories (R 24)** Collection consists of 6 interviews (6 cassette tapes) with members of the Unitarian Universalist Church conducted in the early 1980s. For more documents and photos related to the Unitarian Universalist Church, see OVA 19, OVB 36, P 004, PN 004, POVA 21, PSC 132, SC 41, and MSS 101.

**Mary Fran Abel Collection, "Your Window to the Past" Oral Histories (R 25)** Collection consists of approximately 3 interviews (4 cassette tapes) with local residents. The interviews were conducted by Mary Fran Abel in 1982.

**Muncie Police Department Oral Histories (R 28)** Collection consists of 3 interviews (3 cassette tapes) with members of the Muncie Police Department, including former Chief of Police James Carrey, in 1993. Typed transcripts are available.

**Roger Pelham Oral Histories (R 30)** Collection consists of 1 interview (2 cassette tapes) with Roger Pelham. He discusses his life in Muncie and his work photographing the Indianapolis 500 for the *Indianapolis Star*. The interview was conducted by Nancy Turner in 1994. See also SC 469, V 63, D 4, P 66, and POVC 66.

**Bethel Wadsworth Oral Histories (R 36)** Collection consists of 1 interview (2 cassette tapes) with Cowan's first doctor, Bethel Wadsworth. The interview was conducted by Nancy Turner in 1996.

**Riverside Methodist Church Oral Histories (R 44)** Collection consists of approximately 29 interviews (29 cassette tapes) with members of the Riverside Methodist Church in Muncie, Indiana. The interviews were conducted between 1971 and 1980.

**Thomas A. Sargeant Papers (R 46)** Collection consists of 2 interviews (2 cassette tapes; 3 micro cassette tapes) with members of the Muncie Symphony Orchestra. The interviews were conducted in 1993. See also MSS 202.

**Rosemary Bracken Oral Histories (R 51)** Collection consists of an interview with Rosemary Bracken (1 cassette tape) conducted by Betty Harris, undated.

**Veterans History Oral Histories (R 57, R 58, and R 59)** Collections consist of three interviews (3 cassette tapes, 3 user copies) with World War II veterans. The interviews were conducted by Rodney Gill in August 2003.

**Muncie Jewish Oral History Project II, 2002-2003 (R 63)** Collection consists of 24 interviews (24 cassette tapes, 36 hours). This project was done as a follow-up to the Muncie Jewish Oral History Project. C. Warren Vander Hill interviewed members of the Muncie Temple Beth El congregation. Typed transcripts of these interviews are available. Tapes and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository (<http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**Veterans History Project Oral Histories (R 66)** Collection consists of excerpts of interviews (1 user CD, 1 archival CD) from R 1, R2, R3, R4, and R 78. The excerpts were compiled by Michael Wood in 2006, and a copy is to be sent to the Library of Congress.

**Muncie Labor Oral Histories (R 76)** Collection consists of 15 audio cassette tapes of interviews conducted by Warren Vander Hill between December 2005 and February 2006. The interviews were initiated as part of the Center for Middletown Studies' effort to document recent economic changes in Muncie, Indiana, and record the history of labor unions in Muncie. Also included are typed transcripts for each interview, as well as photographs of each interviewee taken at the time of the interview (PSC 285). Tapes and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository (<http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church Oral Histories (R 77)** Collection consists of 10 interviews (10 hours) with members of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church. This collection is part of the Muncie Catholic Churches Oral History Project. Typed transcripts are available. Tapes and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository (<http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**St. Mary Parish Archives Veterans Oral Histories (R 78)** Collection consists of 11 interviews (11 archival copies on CD; 11 user copies on CD) with World War II veterans from St. Mary Parish in Muncie, Indiana. The interviews were included in the Veterans History Project.

**St. Lawrence Catholic Church Oral Histories (R 79)** Collection consists of 11 interviews (11 hours) with members of the St. Lawrence Catholic Church. This collection is part of the Muncie Catholic Churches Oral History Project. Typed transcripts are available. Tapes and transcripts are available online through the

Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository <http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**St. Mary Catholic Church Oral Histories (R 80)** Collection consists of 10 interviews (10 hours) with members of the St. Mary Catholic Church. This collection is part of the Muncie Catholic Churches Oral History Project. Typed transcripts are available. Tapes and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository <http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**American Indian Recordings (R98)** Collection consists of 5 cassette tapes and CDs from the American Indian Oral History Collection of the Library of Indian Affairs. The interviews were edited by Joseph H. Cash and discuss the Kinship System of the Crow Clan.

**Other Side of Middletown Oral Histories (R 254)** Collection consists of 78 interviews (97 cassette tapes, 97 hours). These interviews were conducted as part of a collaborative ethnography project on Muncie's African-American community. Full transcripts are being prepared, but research notes are available. For transcripts and other documents, see MSS 254. Interviews and transcripts are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository <http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**Muncie Economic Development Oral Histories (R 256)** Collection includes 19 interviews conducted with local civic and business leaders involved in past and current efforts to address long-term economic change in Muncie and Delaware County, Indiana. The interviews were conducted by the Center for Middletown Studies, who referred to the project as "Muncie's Response to Economic Change: An Oral History". Interviews and transcripts for eighteen interviews are available online through the Middletown Digital Oral History Collection in the University Libraries' Digital Media Repository <http://libx.bsu.edu>).

**Interview with Former Mayors Jim Carey and John Hampton, April 25, 1995 (V 267)** Oral history interview conducted by Bill Spurgeon with former Muncie mayors Jim Carey and John Hampton on DVD.

**376<sup>th</sup> Heavy Bombardment Group Oral Histories (V 259)** Collection consists of forty-eight high definition video oral history interviews on DVD and three audio oral history interviews on DVD. The interviews are with members of the 376<sup>th</sup> Heavy Bombardment Group during World War II. The interviews are available online in the Ball State University Libraries' Digital Media Repository (<http://libx.bsu.edu>). Transcription is in progress.

**Cantigny First Division Oral Histories (V 269)** Collection includes forty high definition video oral history interviews on DVD. The interviews are with veterans from the U.S. Army's First Infantry Division – commonly known as the “Big Red One”. They were conducted by students from the Ball State University Department of History with support from the McCormick Tribune Foundation and the First Division Museum. **“My World War II Military Service” (V 268)** Oral History interview with Joseph Taddino, Aerial Gunner and B 24 Liberator.
