History

The Muncie Labor Oral History Project was initiated as part of the Center for Middletown Studies' effort to document recent economic changes in Muncie, Indiana. In order to record the history of labor unions in Muncie, Ball State University professor C. Warren Vander Hill conducted 15 interviews between December 2005 and February 2006 with former labor union members in Muncie.

Scope and Content

This collection contains 15 audio cassette tapes of interviews conducted by Warren Vander Hill between December 2005 and February 2006. Also included are typed transcripts for each interview, as well as photographs of each interviewee taken at the time of the interview. This collection also contains 1 article taken from the Muncie *Star-Press* relating to Charles McKeighen, one of the interviewees.
