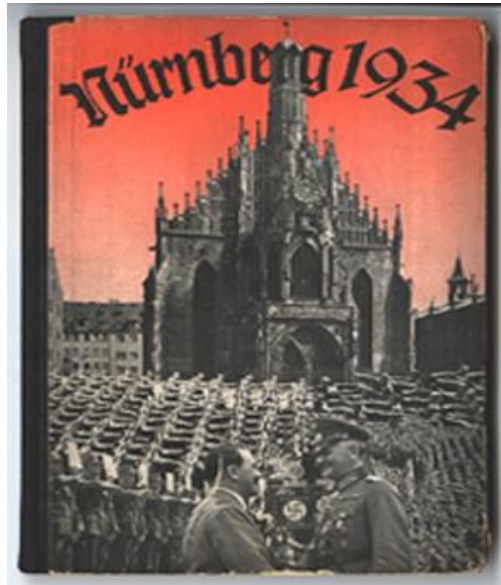




## Nazi Collection Research Resources in the Archives and Special Collections



### Introduction

This bibliography includes the materials that make up the Nazi Collection in the Archives and Special Collections. The collection documents the era of the Third Reich in German history, primarily through German language publications printed during the 1930s and early 1940s. It includes numerous ideological treatises and propaganda items; mostly books, some pamphlets and ephemera. It also includes manuscript collections and photograph collections. The books in the Nazi Collection were donated by Richard Wire and more information about the collection can be found in his publication entitled, *Modern Germany: The Research Collections of Ball State University*.

All materials are located in Archives and Special Collections, Bracken Library 210, and do not circulate. The titles can be found in CardCat. See Archives and Special Collections staff for assistance in locating materials.
